

The Activities of the Family, Morale, Welfare & Recreation Programs

At every Installation where there is a FOIA request received for Family MWR Program records, including Non-Appropriated Fund Contracts (Army-Wide), that Command/Installation FOIA Offices will respond/take proper action to process the request, except for when disclosure cannot be granted. When records cannot be disclosed due to one of the nine exemptions, the Command/Installation FOIA Officer will refer records for release approval to “**the Assistant Chief of Staff for Installation Management (ACSIM)**,” the Initial Denial Authority (IDA), authorized to act on all requests for records relating to planning, programming, execution and operation of Army Installations.
