How the Program Works:

CYS Europe will offer select classes that can lead to a degree in Child Development through Central Texas College (CTC). Three sessions each school year will be offered. Students must be employed a minimum of 3 months prior to application, be current on all installation training requirements, and remain employed within CYS for a minimum of 180 days following completion of any paid course.
