The Employment Readiness Program (ERP) provides career assistance to Soldiers, Family Members, DOD Civilians, Retirees, and Reservists. Employment Readiness Specialists provide workshops as well as one-on-one appointments to assist with job searching, resumes, interviews, networking, and professional development. ERP maintains partnerships with numerous agencies, local and national employers in order to share job opportunities to the Fort Carson community.
